




Benchmarking minor/other applications










Residual household waste per household was above the maximum target of 81.25kgs again this quarter. The annual total was just over the target of 325kgs at 335kgs.

Comparing performance for Q4 2022-23 (latest comparable data available) SDC were the 6th best performing district authority with 81.54kgs.








