1. Making an application.

Where work in relation to a building has begun but not completed, and it is intended to carry out further work in relation to the partly completed work, sufficient plans to show that the intended work will not contravene any requirement in the Principal Regulations, including such plans of any part of the work already carried out, as may be necessary to show that the intended work can be carried out without contravening any such requirement.

2. Uncovering work etc

In assessing the work for compliance with building regulations, the Council may require the applicant to uncover work, take samples and make such tests as necessary.

3. Charges

The correct charge applicable to this work will be determined on receipt of this form and the supporting information.

4. Town and Country Planning
